District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for July 2017

EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

- 1. Station 15 South Bay responded to 121 calls in July with 10 Simultaneous Calls (Back to Back). One of the Simultaneous Calls required Advanced Life Support (1st: 1, 2nd: 0, Both: 0). Of these 121 incidents, 80 were Medical calls with 39 requiring Advanced Life Support provided by Paramedics; A CAL FIRE Firefighter rode in to the hospital with SLO Ambulance one time during the month of July. One call required Staging; Three incidents were reported as Traffic Collision; Six incidents were reported as Fire, 30 as Public Service Assists, and five as Emergency.
- 2. Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies in the month of July a total of 6 times.

ADMINISTRATION

- 3. On July 13, 2017, Reserve Firefighter Noah Munds resigned with 9 months of service to the Community of Los Osos to pursue other career opportunities in the medical field. We wish him success!
- 4. On July 19, 2017, Reserve Firefighter Christopher Wheeler resigned with 9 months of service to the Community of Los Osos. We wish Chris a bright future!
- 5. On July 30, 2017, Station 15 South Bay welcomed CAL FIRE Fire Apparatus Engineer-Paramedic Noah Byrnes as a permanent employee. Noah transferred from the Riverside area and has 5+ years' experience in his current position.
- 6. On July 31, 2017, Reserve Firefighter Virgil Messer resigned with 2+ years of service to the Community of Los Osos. Virgil moved to Norco with his girlfriend while she pursued a nursing career.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

7. During the month of July, Staff began preparations for the upcoming Fire Safety Fair that is scheduled to take place on Saturday, October 8, 2016 from 11am-3pm in the Rite-Aid Parking Lot. This annual event includes tours of the Fire Engines, a true-to-life training in the SLO County Firehouse that teaches children to get low, get out and call for help when they see smoke indoors, demonstrations by SLO Ambulance, SLO County Sheriff's Office, the Estero Bay Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), the Los Osos Focus Group. In addition, Station 15 – South Bay will demonstrate auto extrication techniques using the jaws of life and children can try their hand at our Extinguisher Flash Pan booth or conduct a cliff rescue to save a teddy bear. Come out and meet Smokey Bear and participate in our Stamp Station Game for free homemade baked treats.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

- 8. During the month of July, Staff began collecting competitive price quotes to purchase a new Command Vehicle in FY 2017/2018 that meets the municipal needs of Los Osos, as well as CAL FIRE/SLO County Fire Department.
- 9. On March 19, 2017, E215 was taken out of service due to an open internal switch valve in the transmission that caused the vehicle to only operate in reverse. Engine 262 from Avila was provided to us at no cost. The engine remained in the shop throughout the month of July. Staff anticipates the repair will be complete in late August.
- 10. On June 28, 2017, while responding to a Code 3 medical aid call, Medic Rescue 15 was involved in a non-injury traffic collision. It was towed to Los Osos Auto Body where repairs were made throughout the month of July.
- 11. On July 9, 2017, Station 15 South Bay Staff, in cooperation with former LOCSD Board Member Leonard Moothart and at the request of the family, flew new American and California State flags in front of the fire station in remembrance of former LOCSD Board Member R. Michael Wright. In addition, on-duty Staff attended the funeral service with Medic Engine 15. Station 15 South Bay is truly grateful for Mr. Wright's faithful and diligent service to Los Osos. He will be dearly missed.

FIRE PREVENTION

- 12. From June 5 through June 8, 2017 Station 15 South Bay Reserve Firefighters inspected every lot in the District for violations to the fire code. In total, 288 violations were found. Unfortunately, the initial software data that was obtained was unreadable. CAL FIRE GIS Research Analysts examined and salvaged the data allowing Staff to mail violation notices to property owners in late-July, with a compliance deadline of August 24th.
- 13. On July 31, 2017, Station 15 South Bay Staff met with representatives from St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church to assist in creating a safety exit plan for parishioners and catechism students.
