District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for June 2017

EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

- 1. Station 15 South Bay responded to 123 calls in June with 16 Simultaneous Calls (Back to Back). Eight of the Simultaneous Calls required Advanced Life Support (1st: 4, 2nd: 1, Both: 3). Of these 123 incidents, 86 were Medical calls with 42 requiring Advanced Life Support provided by Paramedics; A CAL FIRE Firefighter rode in to the hospital with SLO Ambulance zero times during the month of June. No calls required Staging; Three incidents were reported as Traffic Collision; Seven incidents were reported as Fire, 21 as Public Service Assists, and nine as Emergency.
- 2. It requires special noting that from June 27 to June 28, 2017, Station 15 South Bay responded to 7 concurrent calls.
- 3. Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies in the month of June a total of 7 times.

ADMINISTRATION

- 4. Station 15 South Bay staff continued the budget preparation process through the month of June. Time was spent ensuring that the current budget was accurate and valid to provide a solid foundation for the next fiscal year budget.
- 5. On June 1, 2017, Reserve Firefighter Todd Takahashi resigned in good standing with 5+ years of service to the Community of Los Osos. Todd was a valuable member of Company 15 and will be missed. We wish him the very best!
- 6. On June 6, 2017, Reserve Firefighter Carley Robson resigned in good standing with 11 months of service to the Community of Los Osos. Carley filled a critical need last summer when many of our Reserves were working as Seasonal Firefighters and therefore could not fill shifts at Station 15 South Bay.
- 7. On June 28, 2017, while responding to a Code 3 medical aid call, Medic Rescue 15 was involved in a non-injury traffic collision at 633 Ramona that left both vehicles undriveable. It was towed to Los Osos Auto Body where it was evaluated by an insurance adjustor and repairs were started.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

- 8. On March 19, 2017, E215 was taken out of service due to an open internal switch valve in the transmission that caused the vehicle to only operate in reverse. Engine 262 from Avila was provided to us at no cost. The engine remained in the shop throughout the month of May.
- 9. On June 3, 2017, Station 15 South Bay Staff participated in the Wishing Well "Summer Fest" Event. The on-duty crew handed out stickers and other trinkets, and provided information to about 50 people regarding fire safety in the home. Medic Engine 15 and Medic Rescue 15 were on display.
- 10. On June 15, 2017, Station 15 Fire Apparatus Engineer Teddy Borja hosted a local youth who is interested in joining the fire service for a 24-hour Ride-Along. This young man was able to observe what it's like to live in a firehouse. He also observed firefighters while responding to emergency calls, and participated in daily chores, exercise routines and vehicle checks/maintenance.
- 11. On June 28, 2017, Station 15 Fire Captain Paramedic Brendan Coalwell responded with the trench trailer to a report of a scaffolding collapse in Pismo Beach with three trapped survivors.

FIRE PREVENTION

- 12. From June 5 through June 8, 2017 Station 15 South Bay Reserve Firefighters inspected every lot in the District for violations to the fire code. In total, 288 violations were found. Unfortunately, the initial software data that was obtained was unreadable. CAL FIRE GIS Research Analysts examined and salvaged all of the data, except for 25 properties. CAL FIRE GIS services are not included as part of the Cooperative Agreement, so their assistance is truly appreciated. Station 15 South Bay Staff is arranging for these remaining 25 properties to be re-inspected in July.
- 13. On June 21 and 22, 2017 Station 15 South Bay hosted 10 kids (each day) from YMCA for a tour of the Firehouse, including a demonstration of structure fire gear and a chance to climb around in the cab of the Fire Engine. At the conclusion, all the kids went home with a sticker badge and other trinkets.
- 14. On June 27, 2017, Station 15 South Bay visited Book Buddies Preschool and met with approximately 12 kids, ages 2-4 years old. Firefighters provided a tour of Medic Engine 15 and Medic Rescue 15, along with basic fire safety tips.
- 15. On June 30, 2017, Station 15 South Bay Staff treated a family of seven to a Fire Engine Tour and a short presentation on personal protective equipment.
