Subject: Agenda Item 3A – October 3, 2019 Board Meeting District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for August and September 2019

### EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

 Station 15 - South Bay responded to 268 calls between July 24 – September 24th, 2019 including 146 Medical Aids, and 32 Traffic Collisions; 16 incidents were reported as Fire, 8 as Hazardous; 40 as Public Service Assists; and 26 as False Alarms.

Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies 18 times between July 24 – September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

#### **ADMINISTRATION**

- 2. During the months of August and September Station 15 South Bay staff continued preparations for the upcoming Fire Safety Fair that is scheduled to take place on Saturday, October 12 from 11am-3pm in the Rite-Aid Parking Lot. This annual event includes tours of the Fire Engines, a true-to-life training in the SLO County Firehouse that teaches children to get low, get out and call for help when they see smoke indoors, demonstrations by SLO Ambulance, the Estero Bay Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), the Red Cross, the Los Osos Focus Group, and many more local agencies. In addition, Station 15 South Bay will demonstrate auto extrication techniques using the jaws of life and children can try their hand at our Extinguisher Flash Pan booth or conduct a cliff rescue to save a teddy bear. In addition to this Station 15 South Bay will be holding a Silent Auction at the Fire Safety Fair to benefit a local young burn victim. Many local donations have been made and Fire Apparatus Engineer Jim Green will be taking donations with a "Fill the Boot" even available all day during the Fair.
- 3. During the month of August, Reserve Firefighters Martin Pierce and Alex Rouffaer resigned. Martin Pierce served the community of Los Osos since 2012 for a total of 7 years. Martin Pierce was a valuable asset and will be focusing on his career as an RN at Sierra Vista Hospital and as a cattle rancher.
- 4. On August 27th 2019 Station 15 South bay assisted with a rehire academy at South Bay Training Center.

### FIRE PREVENTION

- 5. During the month of September, 2019 Station 15 South Bay Firefighters completed vegetation abatement inspections on lots within the District for violations to the Hazardous Vegetation Ordinance No. 2019-01. All lots with violations have been cleared.
- During the month of September Station 15 South Bay put a new roof on the storage C Train. The roof had not been updated for over fifteen years. Stored in the C Train is Personal Protective Equipment, Firefighting Hoses, and Self Contained Breathing Apparatus equipment.

### SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

- 7. During the month of August, 2019 Battalion Chief's new 3411 Ford F250 vehicle was completed and put into service.
- 8. On September 8, 2019 Station 15 South Bay participated in the Family Fun Fair-Grandparents Luncheon at SBCC presented by the Los Osos Rotary. Kids of all ages had the opportunity to tour the engines and were provided trinkets and candy.
- 9. On September 14, 2019, Station 15 South Bay hosted a local youth who is interested in joining the fire service for Ride-Along. This young man was able to observe what it's like to live in a firehouse. He also observed firefighters while responding to emergency calls, and participated in daily chores, exercise routines and vehicle checks/maintenance.
- 10. On September 21, 2019 Station 15 South Bay hosted a Physical Ability Test for ten prospective Reserve Firefighter Applicants. Nine of the Applicants successfully passed and were invited to Oral Interviews on September 22, 2019. Applicants chosen will submit to a medical exam by a physician and pending a medical clearance, applicants will then be provided between 48 and 275 hours of training, depending on pre-existing training prior to being eligible to work shifts or respond to call backs at Station 15 - South Bay.

#### TRAINING

11. On September 5, 2019 Fire Apparatus Engineer Daniel Hauer attended the Terrorism Liaison Officer class. This class provides trains students in the information sharing intelligence-gathering mission, which is crucial to the war on terrorism and a step to becoming a Terrorism Liaison Officer.

The South Bay Fire Department will be contributing all of the money raised from the Fire Safety Fair's bake sale and silent auction to the Gonzales family in Alivia's name. The department will also be taking donations during the Fire Safety Fair with a "Fill The Boot" being available all day. 
