District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for March 2019

### **EMERGENCY ACTIVITY**

Station 15 - South Bay responded to 72 calls between February 27 – March 18th, including 51 Medical Aids, 1 Surf Rescue and 1 Traffic Collision; 2 incidents were reported as Fire, 6 as Hazardous; 6 as Public Service Assists; and 5 as false alarms.

Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies 4 times between February 27 – March 18th.

### **ADMINISTRATION**

2. During the month of March Station 15 – South Bay Firefighters continued inspecting local business for their yearly safety inspections. This is an ongoing project they will continue throughout the year.

### SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

- 3. On March 7<sup>th</sup>, former office manager Harmony Brown received a certificate of appreciation from the CSD during the monthly board meeting. Station 15 South Bay staff, friends, and family attended to recognize her dedication and hard work at Station 15 South Bay for the last 6 years.
- 4. On March 7<sup>th</sup>, new Battalion Chief George Huang took his oath to office in front of board members, CSD staff and Station 15 South Bay staff members. Chief Huang looks forward to supporting the community of Los Osos.

## SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS CONTINUED

5. In late March, Station 15 – South Bay Fire joined together at the Fire Station to update the department photo. The photo is taken bi-annually to exemplify the pride and honor that the 30+ employees who work at the fire station share in service of the Los Osos Community.

#### **TRAINING**

- 6. In March, Station 15 South Bay staff completed a CPR refresher course. In addition to this, all full-time staff completed the annual Continued Professional Training course. This year focused on medical training, administrative updates, live fire training, and command and control training.
- 7. On March 12 and 13th, Firefighter Apparatus Engineer Daniel Hauer completed the Incident Command System 400 course. This course focused on advanced organizational structures on all types of major incidents.
- 8. On March 20, 2019 Station 15 South Bay hosted a mandatory training on the new SCOTT breathing apparatus.
- 9. On March 23, reserve candidate Sean Hanlon completed his confined space rescue awareness training at the South Bay Training Center. He is on track to complete his training by May 2019.


