Adopt a Resolution Declaring the Listed Fire Personal Protective Equipment and Zoll M Series

Defibrillator Surplus to the District's Needs

DESCRIPTION

By motion, adopt Resolution 2014-11 declaring the listed Fire Personal Protective Equipment and Zoll M Series Defibrillator as surplus to District needs and authorize Station 15 – South Bay to donate the Fire Personal Protective Equipment to the CAL FIRE/SLO County Fire Department Service Center for distribution to youth camps and international distribution centers and exchange the Zoll M Series Defibrillator for a credit towards a new Zoll X Series Defibrillator.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Board adopt the following motion/resolution:

Motion: I move the Board adopt Resolution 2014-11 declaring the listed Fire Personal Protective Equipment and Zoll M Series Defibrillator as surplus to District needs and authorize the General Manager to donate the Fire Personal Protective Equipment to CAL FIRE/SLO County Fire Department Service Center for distribution to youth camps and international distribution centers and exchange the Zoll M Series Defibrillator for a credit towards a new Zoll X Series Defibrillator.

DISCUSSION

Staff submits the following information regarding this request:

• The Fire Personal Protective Equipment that Staff wishes to be declared surplus to District is either no longer safe to be used by district firefighters due to its condition or has reached the end of its service life per CAL-OSHA or the Manufacture's recommendations/regulations. The CAL FIRE/SLO County Fire Department through its Service Center currently has a program that supplies fire service youth camps with gear that can be used for training at approved camps. Additionally, the Service Center supplies private parties with fire department equipment that is then donated internationally to fire departments that have no other funding mechanism for Fire Personal Protective Equipment. Over the years, the Service Center has provided hundreds of students and firefighters with gear through this program.

At the June 5, 2014 LOCSD BODs meeting the BODs approved the purchase of a new Zoll X Series
Defibrillator and additional equipment. The Zoll quote for this purchase includes a rebate of \$5,373 if
Station 15 – South Bay Staff return one Zoll M Series Defibrillator. Since the Zoll M Series Defibrillator
will not pass its annual service maintenance it cannot be used by Station 15 – South Bay Paramedics.
Therefore, Staff recommends that the monitor be exchanged for the credit from Zoll for the purchase of
a new monitor.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

If the Zoll M Series Defibrillator is declared surplus, than the district can expect a reduction of over \$5,350 for the new Zoll X Series Monitor purchase. Staff has already submitted a purchase order for the new monitor with the understanding that the Zoll M Series will be exchanged.
