**Subject: Agenda Item 9A – July 5, 2018 Board Meeting
District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for June 2018**

EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

1. Station 15 - South Bay responded to 75 calls between May 31-June 19, including 53 Medical Aids and 4 Traffic Collisions; 5 incidents were reported as Fire, 2 as Hazardous; 8 as Public Service Assists.
2. Company 15 wasn't called to cover the station or respond to emergencies between May 31-June 19.

ADMINISTRATION

3. Station 15 – South Bay staff continued the budget preparation process through the month of June. Time was spent ensuring that the current budget was accurate and valid to provide a solid foundation for the next fiscal year budget.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

4. On June 9, 2018, Station 15 – South Bay hosted a Physical Ability Test for 7 prospective Reserve Firefighter Applicants. All 7 Applicants successfully passed and Oral Interviews were held on June 10, 2018. Six applicants were selected to continue in the hiring process. Paperwork was submitted to CAL FIRE Law Enforcement to begin background checks. Pending a clean check, the applicants will then submit to a medical exam by a physician. Applicants that successfully complete this process will then be provided between 48 and 275 hours of training, depending on pre-existing training prior to being eligible to work shifts or respond to call backs at Station 15 - South Bay. Staff anticipates that all six of these applicants will be eligible to respond upon completion of the Station 15 – South Bay Rookie Taskbook (about 48 hours of training). Reserve Company 15 currently has 18 of 25 positions filled.
5. On June 19, 2018, CAL FIRE/Station 15 – South Bay Fire Staff transported the new Medic Squad 15 to the CAL FIRE North County Mechanical Shop to complete the build-up. This work is being completed to create the most efficient organization of emergency response equipment within the vehicle, providing the opportunity for greater response times while on calls.

FIRE PREVENTION

6. From June 4 through June 7, 2018 Station 15 – South Bay Reserve Firefighters inspected every lot in the District for violations to the fire code. In total, 421 violations were found. (Vegetation: 199, Address: 222, Rubbish: 1) were found and notices were sent to the property owners. They were given four weeks to correct the violations.
7. On June 13, 2018, Station 15 – South Bay visited Book Buddies Preschool and met with approximately 12 kids, ages 2-5 years old. Firefighters provided a tour of Medic Engine 15 and Medic Rescue 15, along with basic fire safety tips.
8. On June 21, 2018, Station 15 – South Bay hosted 70 kids from YMCA for a tour of the Firehouse, including a demonstration of structure fire gear and a chance to climb around in the cab of the Fire Engine. At the conclusion, all the kids went home with a sticker badge and other trinkets.
