Meeting

Deputy Beene gave a Sheriff's Report.

Greg Klingenberg gave a Highway's Patrol Report.

Kerry Brown gave the County Staff Report. The Los Osos community development and short-term vacation rental plans have been submitted to the Coastal Commission. The Los Osos Community Plan is the priority. The short-term rental has been separated from the community development plan. There currently is no timeline for review completion.

Supervisor Bruce Gibson gave a report. There's going to be a special meeting around the Pismo Beach Off-roading Vehicle Area in March. There is continued efforts on rent relief for tenants and landlords. The County has received \$17M in funds from State and Federal authorizes. They are going to craft an outreach program to address the needs of county residents.

The State should be allocating money in the next month or two to help with Homeless Housing and Services.

SLO County could be moving to red tier if we can keep COVID numbers low for another week. The vaccine doses distribution from the State has been inconsistent and looking to improve to get more consistent distribution. The county is staffed to do 15K vaccines per week. Currently doing about 10K/week based on current supply. County is also looking to improve vaccine appointments and registrations for eligible recipients.

Troy Gatchell gave Los Osos CSD report.

Chamber of Commerce was reported on by Lynette Tornatzky. The Chamber is still closed. Currently the Chamber is working on a new pamphlet to the community.

Minutes from the January Meeting were approved.

LOCAC Committee reports were given by various members with not many updates to report.

Consent Agenda was approved for DRC2020-00227 Welton Project for single-family residence and DRC2020-00226 Grijalva to replace an existing deck within the Estero Planning Area.

The project will restore 40 acres of declining palustrine coastal wetlands and 16 acres of upland coastal dune scrub habitat in order to enhance and increase habitat for sensitive species and reduce sediment loading into Morro Bay Estuary. Project will remove upland homestead access and infrastructure, breech levees to reconnect the floodplain, and restore natural habitat. LOCAC unanimously approved the project
