District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for August 2017

# **EMERGENCY ACTIVITY**

- 1. Starting August 20, 2017, the Station 15 South Bay Fire log report is being generated from the State dispatch system. This automated statistical information ensures accuracy regarding call type, location, frequency of calls and response times.
- 2. Station 15 South Bay responded to 100 calls in August, including 72 Medical Aids; One call required Staging; Five incidents were reported as Traffic Collision; 12 incidents were reported as Fire, 16 as Public Service Assists, and three incidents were outside of the District.
- 3. Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies in the month of August a total of 3 times.

### **ADMINISTRATION**

4. During the month of August, Staff collected competitive price quotes to purchase a new Command Vehicle in FY 2017/2018 that meets the municipal needs of Los Osos, as well as CAL FIRE/SLO County Fire Department.

### SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

5. During the month of August, Staff continued preparations for the upcoming Fire Safety Fair that is scheduled to take place on Saturday, October 7 from 11am-3pm in the Rite-Aid Parking Lot. This annual event includes tours of the Fire Engines, a true-to-life training in the SLO County Firehouse that teaches children to get low, get out and call for help when they see smoke indoors, demonstrations by SLO Ambulance, SLO County Sheriff's Office, the Estero Bay Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), the Los Osos Focus Group. In addition, Station 15 – South Bay will demonstrate auto extrication techniques using the jaws of life and children can try their hand at our Extinguisher Flash Pan booth or conduct a cliff rescue to save a teddy bear. Come out and meet Smokey Bear and participate in our Stamp Station Game for free homemade baked treats.

# SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

- 6. In August, Station 15 South Bay started planning for Fire Prevention Week, to be held from October 8-14. The campaign message this year is "Every Second Counts: Plan 2 Ways Out!" and is a powerful reminder that fire escape planning saves lives. Included in this campaign is the Burn Relay. This year, on Thursday October 12, Medic Engine 215 will visit elementary schools from Nipomo to Los Osos teaching children about fire safety. At the end of the day, a check will be presented to the Alisa Ann Ruch Burn Foundation of annual donations collected by Reserve Company 15.
- 7. On March 19, 2017, E215 was taken out of service due to an open internal switch valve in the transmission that caused the vehicle to only operate in reverse. Engine 262 from Avila was provided to us at no cost. The engine remained in the shop throughout the month of August and was returned on September 7, 2017.
- 8. On August 1, 2017, Medic Rescue 15 was returned to Station 15 South Bay. While responding to a Code 3 medical aid call in late June, Medic Rescue 15 was involved in a non-injury traffic collision. It was towed to Los Osos Auto Body where the necessary repairs were made.
- 9. On August 28, 2017, Station 15 South Bay hosted a local woman who is interested in joining the fire service for a Ride-Along. This individual was able to observe what it's like to live in a firehouse. She also observed firefighters while responding to emergency calls, and participated in daily chores, exercise routines and vehicle checks/maintenance.

#### FIRE PREVENTION

6. During the month of August, Station 15 – South Bay Staff and Reserve Firefighters conducted second inspections on the 288 original lots found in violation of the fire code. In total, 117 violations remained (Vegetation Violations: 112, Address Violations: 5, Multiple Violations: 0) and notices were sent to the property owners. They were given two weeks to correct the violations.
