District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for July 2014

EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

 Station 15 - South Bay responded to 109 calls in July with 4 Simultaneous Calls (Back to Back). Two of these Simultaneous Calls required Advanced Life Support. Of these 109 incidents, 78 were Medical calls with 35 requiring Advanced Life Support provided by Paramedics; On one of these calls, a CAL FIRE Firefighter rode in to the hospital with SLO Ambulance. Three incidents were reported as Traffic Collision; Two incidents were reported as Fire, 19 as Public Service Assists, and ten as Emergency.

Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies in the month of July a total of 15 times.

ADMINISTRATION

- 3. On July 21, 2014, Reserve Firefighter Justin Trotter submitted a letter of resignation, effective immediately, to pursue a career as a Contract Firefighter in Antarctica and South Pole, as well as a Park Ranger with the National Park Service. Justin was a valuable member of the Department for 10 years and we wish him a bright future.
- 4. On July 21, 2014 Reserve Firefighter Brian Merrill submitted a letter of resignation after being promoted to Firefighter II/Paramedic with CAL FIRE, Riverside Unit. Brian was a dependable and valuable asset to Station 15 South Bay throughout his 4+ years of employment.

TRAINING

5. During the month of July, Station 15 – South Bay advertised in local media and sent out press releases to several media outlets regarding new applicants for our Reserve Company. Upon the application deadline Staff had collected 21 applications. Two were determined to be incomplete and the applicants were notified. The remaining applicants were scheduled for a Physical Ability test to be held on August 9, 2014. The application process is the first step in a multi month hiring process for Company 15. Prospective applicants that successfully complete the Physical Ability will be interviewed, receive a background check, and be medically cleared by a physician. Applicants that successfully complete this process will then be provided between 48 and 275 hours of training, depending on pre-existing training prior to being eligible to work shifts or respond to call backs at Station 15-South Bay. Staff anticipates that the first of these applicants will be eligible to respond in January, 2015. Reserve Company 15 currently has 21 of 25 positions filled with about 2 on approved Leave of Absences. Staff expects to hire 4 depending on training needs of prospective Reserves.

TRAINING

6. On July 8, 2014, Battalion Chief Veneris and Fire Captain – Paramedic Coalwell attended the XSL Incident Management Team meeting. The XSL IMT is a Type 3 Incident Management Team in its first year of operation in San Luis Obispo County. During this meeting, emergency responders from various disciplines, including fire, law, hazardous materials and public health discussed pandemic emergency response with the County Health Officer, Dr. Borenstein.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

7. During the month of July, Chief Veneris' vehicle 3411 was sent to Perry Ford for routine maintenance and repairs to the front end and steering components. The final cost of these repairs was paid for through Schedule D of the Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement with CAL FIRE/SLO County Fire Department.

FIRE PREVENTION

- 8. During the month of July, third and fourth inspections were conducted on fire code violations in the District. Of the 160 original lots, 12 were still in violation and certified notices were sent to the property owners with two weeks to correct. In addition, CAL FIRE Staff made personal contact with several property owners and provided information, resources and support.
- 9. On July 2, 2014, Station 15 South Bay met with approximately 25 children at Bayview Elementary. Firefighters provided a tour of Medic Engine 15, Medic Rescue 15, an overview of Firefighting gear along with basic fire safety tips.
