District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for November 2018**

**EMERGENCY ACTIVITY**

1. Station 15 - South Bay responded to 98 calls between October 17-November 23, including 108 Medical Aids and 4 Traffic Collisions; 13 incidents were reported as Fire, 4 as Hazardous; 16 as Public Service Assists.

Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies 10 times between October 17-November 23.

**ADMINISTRATION**

2. Station 15 – South Bay staff began the budget preparation process in the month of November. Time was spent ensuring that the current budget was accurate and valid to provide a solid foundation for the next fiscal year budget.
3. Throughout the month of November, Station 15 – South Bay advertised on Craigslist and sent out press releases to several media outlets regarding new applicants for our Reserve Company. The application deadline was Friday, November 30, 2018.
4. Throughout the month of November, California experienced several devastating wildfires that destroyed thousands of homes and lives. The Station 15 – South Bay Firefighters were fortunate to be able to stay in Los Osos during this time and continue to provide services to the community. When major threats like these wildfires occur, CAL FIRE activates a system by which every Firefighter in the State remains on duty until the threat is contained. Many of our local Firefighters served for 14-20 consecutive days in Los Osos, and the community continuously showered us with support and concern. Thank you, Los Osos!

## **SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS**

5. During the month of November, Station 15 – South Bay, in cooperation with KSBY Television and the San Luis Obispo County Firefighters Benevolent Association kicked off the Operation Santa Claus and the Season of Hope charity events, providing unwrapped presents to needy children under the care of San Luis Obispo County Child Protective Services and the Season of Hope provides food and toys to local Food Banks and Toy Agencies.
6. On November 10, 2018, Station 15 – South Bay Fire Staff surprised a 3 year-old local boy and his friends/family at his home by helping him celebrate his Firefighter themed birthday party. The firefighters treated the children to tours of Medic Engine 15, Medic Squad 15 and handed out fire hats and trinkets.
7. On November 11, 2018, Station 15 – South Bay personnel attended the annual Veteran's Day Service at Los Osos Valley Mortuary.
8. On November 26, 27 and 28, 2018, Station 15 – South Bay hosted the Sunnyside Pre-School on a Station tour of approximately 21 children (ranging from 1-4 years) each day, along with their parents. Firefighters provided a tour of Medic Engine 15 and Medic Rescue 15, along with basic fire safety tips. In addition, each child was provided with Fire Hats, stickers and other trinkets (see attached thank you card).
