October 2015 Seawater	District Engineering Miller summarized the findings of the draft semi-annual Seawater Intrusion Monitoring report from Cleath Harris. He reminded the public that there are a network of lower aquifer monitoring wells that are monitored twice a year to determine the extent and status of seawater intrusion.
Intrusion Monitoring Report	He reported that seawater intrusion is continuing but at a slightly slower rate; that a number of wells had decreased chloride levels however the Palisades well had an increase; that there was a slight increase in water levels in the wells; and that the reduction in pumping and conservation measures that have been put in place may have resulted in the slight decreased rate of the seawater intrusion but that additional monitoring events will be needed before long term trends can be confirmed.
