**District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for August 2016**

**EMERGENCY ACTIVITY**

1. Station 15 - South Bay responded to 108 calls in August with 6 Simultaneous Calls (Back to Back). Four of the Simultaneous Calls required Advanced Life Support (1st: 2, 2nd: 1, Both: 1). Of these 108 incidents, 83 were Medical Calls with 51 requiring Advanced Life Support provided by Paramedics; A CAL FIRE Firefighter rode in to the hospital with SLO Ambulance one time during the month of August. One call required Staging; Five incidents were reported as Traffic Collision; Three incidents were reported as Fire, 15 as Public Service Assists, and seven as Emergency.
2. Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies in the month of August a total of seven times.

**ADMINISTRATION**

3. On April 17, 2016 Medic Engine 215 was sent to the Emergency Vehicle Group in Anaheim for mechanical and electrical issues and remained in the shop throughout the month of May, June July and August. While Medic Engine 215 was in the shop, SLO County Medic Engine 212 was assigned to Station 15 - South Bay to maintain two vehicles for emergency response.

**SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS**

4. During the month of August, Staff continued preparations for the upcoming Fire Safety Fair that is scheduled to take place on Saturday, October 8, 2016 from 11am-3pm in the Rite-Aid Parking Lot. This annual event includes tours of the Fire Engines, a true-to-life training in the SLO County Firehouse that teaches children to get low, get out and call for help when they see smoke indoors, demonstrations by SLO Ambulance, SLO County Sheriff's Office, the Estero Bay Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), the Los Osos Focus Group. In addition, Station 15 – South Bay will demonstrate auto extrication techniques using the jaws of life and children can try there hand at our Extinguisher Flash Pan booth or conduct a cliff rescue to save a teddy bear. Come out and meet Smokey Bear and participate in our Stamp Station Game for free homemade baked treats.

## **SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS**

5. In August, Station 15 – South Bay started planning for Fire Prevention Week, to be held from October 9 – 15. The campaign message this year is to install smoke alarms in every bedroom, outside each separate sleeping area, and on every level of your home, including the basement. Larger homes may need more alarms. Included in this campaign is the Burn Relay. This year, on Thursday October 13, SLO County Medic Engine 212 will visit elementary schools from Nipomo to Los Osos teaching children about fire safety. At the end of the day, a check will be presented to the Alisa Ann Ruch Burn Foundation of annual donations collected by Reserve Company 15.

## **FIRE PREVENTION**

6. Through the month of August 2016, Station 15 – South Bay Staff and Reserve Firefighters completed final inspections on the 12 remaining lots found in violation of the fire code. By the end of the month, all lots were found to be in compliance, except for one parcel which was turned over to CAL FIRE Law Enforcement for follow-up.
