SUBJECT: Agenda Item 6F - August 2, 2018 Board Meeting

Adopt Resolution Authorizing the Purchase of the Replacement

Command Vehicle and Related Emergency Equipment

DESCRIPTION

The Command Vehicle is an Emergency Response Vehicle used by the Fire Department that requires immediate replacement. Staff received bids and is requesting the Board to authorize the purchase to the most responsive bidder, Downtown Ford Sales, and related emergency equipment in an amount not to exceed \$80,000.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

This item will be approved along with the Consent Calendar unless it is pulled by a Director for separate consideration. If so, Staff recommends that the Board adopt the following motion:

Motion: I move that the Board adopt Resolution 2018-25 authorizing the purchase of a replacement Command Vehicle and related emergency equipment in an amount not to exceed \$80,000; and authorize the General Manager to execute the purchase with Downtown Ford Sales and receive the vehicle.

DISCUSSION

The current South Bay Fire Department Command Vehicle is a 2010 Ford Expedition. With Board approval, the new Command Vehicle will be designed to California State Standards to enable the Battalion Chief to respond and command a variety of incidents with the tools and resources necessary. This vehicle will be equipped with an emergency light and sound package to meet California Code for Emergency Response, as well as specialized lockers and storage units. In order to access rural/unpaved sections of Los Osos, North Coast Battalion and the State of California, it is necessary for Command Vehicle to be equipped with 4-wheel drive. This vehicle, as described, will allow for quick response to incidents that vary from local and state wildland fire response, large scale medical calls, mass casualty incidents (MCI), hazardous material response, as well as active shooter scenarios.

CAL FIRE/SLO County Fire Department generally recommends that Command Vehicles are replaced between 8 to 10 years of age. Due to the mileage and ongoing vehicle repairs, it is Staff's recommendation to replace this vehicle in FY 2018/2019.

Station 15 – South Bay Fire Station has been funding the Fund 301, Line Item 3110 Reserve for Replacement–Fire Vehicle or Equipment since approximately 2005. This Line Item is intended to fund the replacement of all South Bay Fire Department vehicles and has sufficient funds for this purchase.

After discussions with General Manager Osborne and the Emergency Services Advisory Committee at the February 21, 2017 and March 21, 2017 meetings, it was recommended that Staff prepare an adjustment to the Line Item 3110 Reserve for Replacement – Fire Vehicle or Equipment document, as well as prepare a Request for Proposal for a new Command Vehicle.

South Bay Fire Staff has been directed to design a Command Vehicle that meets the municipal needs of Los Osos, as well as CAL FIRE/SLO County Fire Department. The main goal of this directive was to allow the Battalion Chief to quickly and efficiently respond and operate the vehicle within the North Coast Battalion.

The Downtown Ford Sales quote was provided by contract from the State of California. Because of this, it is guaranteed to meet all of the requirements for a State Response Vehicle and have the features and quality that we'd expect. Furthermore, there is an assurance that the vehicle will be consistent with other State Vehicles in the CAL FIRE system, lessening out-of-service time and LOCSD costs when parts and repairs are necessary.

The Command Vehicle is expected to cost no more than \$80,000.00 total for replacement. All below quotes include a 3 year 36,000 mile Bumper-to-Bumper limited warranty, 5 years or 60,000 miles (whichever comes first) Powertrain Limited Warranty.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

It is estimated that the cost of a new Command Vehicle that will meet the needs of Station 15 - South Bay Fire in regards to maneuverability, storage capacity, updated technology and overall reliability will not exceed \$80,000.

Sufficient funds are available in Fund 301 Line Item 3110 Reserve for Replacement–Fire Vehicle or Equipment to cover the replacement cost of the Command Vehicle.

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LOS OSOS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT COMMAND VEHICLE

WHEREAS, the Los Osos Community Services District is formed and operating in accordance with California Government Code Section 61100 et seq. to provide fire protection services, rescue services, hazardous material emergency response services in the same manner as a fire protection district, formed pursuant to the Fire Protection District Law, Part 2.7 (commencing with Section 13800) of Division 12 of the Health and Safety Code; and

WHEREAS, the District has developed a replacement schedule and reserve funding source for its critical vehicles and equipment within the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the District under its contract with CAL FIRE is required to replace its critical vehicles and equipment according to a reasonable replacement schedule, and if vehicle maintenance costs paid by the County Fire Department exceed a reasonable amount annually, then the District may be required to purchase replacement vehicles in advance of budgeted replacement schedules; and

WHEREAS, the District's command vehicle has been in a state of disrepair and out of service an unacceptable number of times over the past five years; and

WHEREAS, the frequency, complexity and severity of the failures of the command vehicle have been increasing exponentially in the past 36 months; and

WHEREAS, delay in replacement of the command vehicle is and will continue to negatively affect the quality of emergency response services provided by the Battalion Chief; and

WHEREAS, CAL FIRE staff and District management agree, and have recommended to and received a Board recommendation of vehicle replacement approval from the District Emergency Services Advisory Committee, with vehicle funding recommended to be allocated from the Fire Vehicle or Equipment Replacement Reserve; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Los Osos Community Services District Board of Directors authorizes the General Manager to sign the associated purchase order.
