#### WATER PRODUCTION INFORMATION

The total production for the month of **January 2018** was approximately **12.8 million gallons (MG)** this equates to an average daily demand of **413,000** gallons. This represents an **increase** in production from last year by approximately **4.53%**.

Using the state's formula to calculate residential usage per capita per day, for the month of **January 2018** our residential customers used **55.2** gallons per person per day.

#### PRODUCTION AND RUNTIME HOURS BY WELL SITE

The following tables break down the production by well site and runtime on the pump motors for the month of **January 2018**. Totals for last year are included for comparison:

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# **UTILITIES DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE**

During the month of January 2018, the Utilities crew performed all required operations and maintenance tasks. The various tasks and facilities maintained are:

#### **WATER DISTRIBUTION AND TREATMENT**

- Daily, weekly, and monthly water quality sampling, analysis and reporting, for all well sites and throughout the distribution system.
- · Monthly meter reading.
- Meter change out program.
- Attended Trench safety course in San Luis Obispo.
- Chlorine tank maintenance at 8<sup>th</sup> Street well site.
- Begin implementation of Computerized Maintenance Management System, e-maintenance.

#### **DRAINAGE WDID # 3 40M2000133**

The District continue to operate and comply with the General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for storm water discharges for small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4). - Performed drainage basin maintenance at Cabrillo Basin.
- Callout during storm of January 8-9, received 3.2 inches of rain.
- Work completed on installing and operating large transfer pump at 8<sup>Th</sup> st Drainange facility.
- Reconfigure existing security cage at 8th Street Drainagen facility.

### **BAYRIDGE ESTATES and VISTA DE ORO COLLECTIONS**

Until finalization of transfer is complete, the District crew is responsible for responding to any customer concerns or issue within the collection systems.

The contracts for transfer of ownership were on the February 6, 2018 consent agenda of the County Board of Supervisors meeting. We are waiting for confirmation of the approved contracts.


