Adopt Resolution 2023-17 Approving Sole Source Contracts with Hartzell Construction for the Emergency Repair of the Cabrillo

Storm Water Detention Basin.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

This item will be approved along with the Consent Calendar unless it is pulled by a Director for separate consideration. If so, Staff recommends that the Board adopt the following motion:

Motion: I recommend the Board adopt Resolutions 2023-17 approving non-competitive contracts with Hartzell Construction.

DISCUSSION

After the January 9, 2023 Vista de Oro incident, staff gathered a team of consultants and contractors to discuss temporary and permanent emergency repairs to the storm water basin. On January 12, 2023, the Board adopted a resolution delegating authority to the General Manager to enter into public works contracts consistent with California Public Contract Code Section 22050(B). The Board has reaffirmed the delegation through subsequent resolutions on January 17, 24 and February 2, 7, 14, and 21, 2023.

To continue the work already in progress and to be consistent with the District Procurement Policy and FEMA requirements for reimbursement, the Board needs to pass resolutions for sole source contracts with Hartzell Construction to perform the emergency repair work.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The District has received estimates from Hartzell Construction for the emergency repair project. The estimate of \$432,000 is based on the preliminary design of the project. A more refined estimate will be submitted once the final design is completed. Staff will return to the Board with a contract for Hartzell Construction upon completion of the design.

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LOS OSOS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT (DISTRICT) APPROVING A NON-COMPETITIVE CONTRACT WITH HARTZELL CONSTRUCTION (CONTRATOR) FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES RELATED TO THE EMERGENCY REPAIR OF THE CABRILLO ESTATES STORM WATER DETENTION BASIN

WHEREAS, California Public Contract Code Section 22050(a) provides that in the case of an emergency, a public agency, pursuant to a four-fifths vote of its governing body, may repair or replace a public facility, take any directly related and immediate action required by that emergency, and procure the necessary equipment, services, and supplies for those purposes, without giving notice for bids to let contracts; and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2023, the Board adopted Resolution 2023-03 declaring an emergency and delegating authority to the General Manager pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22050(b); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Districts Procurement Policy, Section 4.6 (b) for non-competitive negotiations for professional services the consultant satisfies the three criteria to be considered for a non-competitive contract; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to FEMA definition and guidelines, an exigency situation exists due to the need to avoid, prevent, or alleviate serious harm or injury, financial or otherwise, to the recipient or subrecipient, and use of competitive procurement proposals would prevent the urgent action required to address the situation; and

WHEREAS, the circumstances to justify a non-competitive procurement as listed in C.F.R. § 200.320(c) of the FEMA guidelines for non-competitive procurement will not permit a delay resulting competitive solicitation as listed in 2 C.F.R. § 200.320(c); and

WHEREAS, contractor is qualified to provide the construction services required to perform the needed emergency repair work; and

WHEREAS, the estimated contract amount of \$432,000 will be is considered reasonable when compared to cost estimates for similar services related to other District projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LOS OSOS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

 Based on the declared emergency conditions, the District's Procurement Policy, FEMA guidelines for non-competitive contracting, the consultant's experience working on the emergency repair project to date, and their competitive cost proposal, approval of a noncompetitive contract is appropriate.
