District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for December 2018

EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

Station 15 - South Bay responded to 142 calls between November 24-December 23, including 100
Medical Aids and 7 Traffic Collisions; 5 incidents were reported as Fire, 9 as Hazardous; 21 as Public
Service Assists.

Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies 5 times between November 24-December 23.

ADMINISTRATION

- Station 15 South Bay staff continued the budget preparation process in the month of December. Time
 was spent ensuring that the current budget was accurate and valid to provide a solid foundation for the
 next fiscal year budget.
- 3. On December 15, 2018, Station 15 South Bay hosted a Physical Ability Test for 14 prospective Reserve Firefighter Applicants. Eleven of the Applicants successfully passed and were invited to Oral Interviews on December 16, 2018 with four applicants being selected to continue in the hiring process. These applicants will submit to a medical exam by a physician and pending a medical clearance, applicants will then be provided between 48 and 275 hours of training, depending on pre-existing training prior to being eligible to work shifts or respond to call backs at Station 15 South Bay. Staff anticipates that all four applicants will be eligible to respond upon completion of the Station 15 South Bay Rookie Taskbook (about 48 hours of training). Reserve Company 15 currently has 20 of 25 positions filled.
- 4. On December 17, 2018, Reserve Firefighter Hayden Mislavsky resigned to pursue a job with SLO City Fire. He expressed great appreciation to the Station 15 South Bay Staff for the opportunities and experience he was able to gain while serving the Community of Los Osos over the past year. We wish Hayden and his new bride the best of success in their future.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

- 5. During the month of December, Station 15 South Bay, in cooperation with KSBY Television and the San Luis Obispo County Firefighters Benevolent Association kicked off the Operation Santa Claus and the Season of Hope charity events, providing unwrapped presents to needy children under the care of San Luis Obispo County Child Protective Services. The Season of Hope provides food and toys to local Food Banks and Toy Agencies.
- 6. Station 15 South Bay began a landscaping project in the front yard of the Fire Station in December. Utilizing drought tolerant plants throughout, the firefighters also plan to incorporate seating, for walk-in guests to use, as well as a new free public library box that is being designed, built and donated by Los Osos local, Tom Wright. We would like to say a big thank you to Tom for such a generous gift that we know will be a valuable asset to all the visiting kids at our station.
- 7. On December 7, 2018, Station 15 South Bay attended the Los Osos Christmas Tree Lighting event at the South Bay Community Center and assisted with crowd and traffic control.
- 8. On December 14th, 2018, Station 15 South Bay hosted 20 kids, ages 3-5, from Sunnyside Head Start for a tour of the Firehouse. This included a demonstration of structure fire gear and a chance to climb around in the cab of the Fire Engine. At the conclusion, all the kids went home with a sticker badge, fire hat and other trinkets.
- 9. On December 15, 2018, Station 15 South Bay attended the Los Osos Holiday Parade. Medic Engine 15, Medic Rescue 15, Engine 215 and Utility 15 all represented Station 15 South Bay with their family and friends.
- 10. On December 15, 2018, the Annual Needs 'N Wishes Holiday Fundraiser, sponsored by South Bay Seniors People Helping People, collected numerous barrels of new toys to assist in the SLO Firefighters Benevolent Association's Operation Santa Claus Project. Our sincerest appreciation and thanks for all of their great work in our community!
