Agenda Item 2: Amending & Restating Title 2

The primary changes to Title 2 are:

- 1. The clarification of the property owner's responsibility for bill payment if a tenant becomes delinquent in Section 2.01.05.
- 2. Changing the reference from the District's Specifications and Drawings to the County of San Luis Obispo's Public Improvement Standards in multiple sections.
- 3. Changing all references to specific District fees in Title 2 to reference fees adopted by District Resolution to make it easier to adjust fees in the future.

Consideration of a Letter to the SLO County Integrated Waste Management Regarding the Repeal of an Ordinance Banning Polystyrene



What is Polystyrene & why prohibit its use?

Expanded Polystyrene (EPS) or Polystyrene, is a **petroleum-based non-biodegradable foam** which the EPA considers a **"possible human carcinogen"** and **"that such materials can have serious impacts upon human health, wildlife, and aquatic environment.**



Background:

- The IWMA adopted an ordinance prohibiting the sale and use of polystyrene on September 11, 2019.
- The prohibition was to take effect 6 months after adoption was delayed for a year due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- At the IWMA March 10, 2021 Board meeting, their Board passed the introduction of an ordinance to repeal the prohibitions with final passage schedule for April 14, 2021.



Background:

- At the March 4th Board meeting, after hearing public comment regarding the rescinding of the polystyrene ordinance, the Board expressed interest in sending a letter of support for the prohibition to the IWMA Board and Mr. Robert Enns, the Special District representative on the IWMA Board.
- Per the direction, attached to this report is a draft letter for your consideration.



Recommendation:

- 1. Provide direction on a letter to IWMA as deemed appropriate and authorize the President to sign and send a letter to the IWMA Board.
- 2. Direct staff to provide the letter directly to Robert Enns, the Special District representative on the IWMA Board.
