District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for June 2016

EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

- 1. Station 15 South Bay responded to 89 calls in June with 1 Simultaneous Call (Back to Back). The Simultaneous Call required Advanced Life Support (1st: 0, 2nd: 0, Both: 1). Of these 89 incidents, 66 were Medical Calls with 50 requiring Advanced Life Support provided by Paramedics: A CAL FIRE Firefighter rode in to the hospital with SLO Ambulance one time during the month of June. No calls required Staging; Three incidents were reported as Traffic Collision; Four incidents were reported as Fire, 14 as Public Service Assists, and five as Emergency.
- 2. Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies in the month of June a total of five times.

ADMINISTRATION

- 3. On April 17, 2016 Medic Engine 215 was sent to the Emergency Vehicle Group in Anaheim for mechanical and electrical issues and remained in the shop throughout the month of May and June. While Medic Engine 215 was in the shop, SLO County Medic Engine 212 was assigned to Station 15 - South Bay to maintain two vehicles for emergency response.
- 4. From June 10-14, 2016 the Command Vehicle (B-3411) went out of service with a coolant leak. It was towed to Perry Ford where it was determined that the heater core lines had failed. Both lines were replaced at a cost of \$1,172, paid for through the Cooperative Fire Protection Agraamant
- 5. In June, Station 15 South Bay Illied Carley Tobach tomporary Reserve runs beer for the fire season. Robson has been employed as a Paid-Call Firefighter at the Station in SLO for many years and, therefore, possessed all of the minimum qualifications necessary to be hired at Station 15 immediately. We are proud to have Carley as the newest member of Company 15.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

- On June 2, 2016, CAL FIRE engine crews from Cayucos and San Luis Obispo Headquarters spent a full day abating vegetation and maintaining the fuel break at Monarch Grove at no cost to the District.
- 7. On June 3, 2016, Station 15 South Bay hosted a Special Day at the Firehouse for a 6-year old child from Monarch Grove Elementary. The boy, along with 4 friends, enjoyed a tour of the city in the Fire Engine. Parents and family joined the fun with a tour of the Firehouse and an ice cream party hosted by the Firefighters. This prize was won at the Annual Needs'N'Wishes Fundraiser.
- On June 6, 2016, Templeton Floor Company began the installation of new carpet and tile throughout much of Station 15. This anticipated expense was budgeted for through Fund 301 Capital Projects.
- 9. On June 7, 2016, Station 15 South Bay Staff treated 13 kids (ages 2-5) of a Home Daycare Facility (located on S. Court) to a Fire Engine Tour and a short presentation on personal protective equipment. Following the presentation, each child received a fire hat and a bag of trinkets for both fun and education.
- 10. On June 11, 2016, a 3-year old Los Osos girl and her family celebrated her birthday at the Firehouse, with a pizza party, presents and of course, cake. This prize was won for participating in our Stamp Station Game at the Annual Fire Safety Fair. The little girl, along with 7 friends and 12 adults, also enjoyed a tour of the Firehouse and Fire Engines, along with a bunch of fun and educational trinkets to take home.
- 11. On June 21, 2016, Station 15 South Bay Staff provided a fire investigation presentation to a Cub Scout Troop of 70 kids, ages 7-10, at the Church of the Nazarene.

FIRE PREVENTION

12. From June 1 through June 6, 2016 Station 15 – South Bay Staff and Reserve Firefighters inspected every lot in the District for violations to the fire code. In total, 489 violations (Vegetation Violations: 440, Address Violations: 32, Multiple Violations: 17) were found and notices were sent to the property owners. They were given two weeks to correct the violations.
